

## Windows 8/10 x64 Unsigned Driver Override

One of the new security measures in Windows 8/10 is automatically blocking the installation of unsigned drivers. The following is a temporary way around this issue until we can rewrite the driver files to conform to the Windows 8/10 standard.

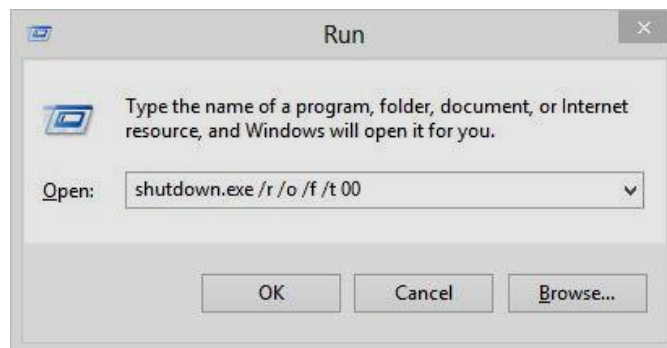


Do the following after removing all inserted USB flash drives...

1. Launch the Run Command dialog by pressing the Windows Key + R
2. Enter the following command into the Run dialog box:

```
shutdown.exe /r /o /f /t 00
```

(there is a space before each / and the last 2 characters are zeros)



3. Click the "OK" button
4. You will now be on the "Choose an option" screen
5. Select "Troubleshoot"
6. Select "Advanced options"
7. Select "Start-up Settings"

8. "Start-up Settings" screen displays a list of options and a "Restart" button
9. Click the "Restart" button to restart the system
10. "Start-up Settings" screen now allows you to select a boot option
11. Select "Disable Driver Signature Enforcement" (number 7 on the list)
12. Once the system starts, install the drivers as you would on Windows



13. When finished installing the drivers, restart system in normal mode
